Job Overview

2 Towns Vision:

We aspire to create craft cider that is accessible to the people, utilizing the most advanced cider making standards, and quality Northwest ingredients, without being afraid to do things a little differently. Much like our product, 2 Towns as a company is fun, unique, and filled with energy. Our crew is what makes what we do possible, and we are committed to fostering an environment of fairness, empowerment, and security.

Job Summary:

2 Towns Ciderhouse is dependent on making sales and developing and fostering the relationships with our distribution partners to meet that objective. We are equally dependent on clear and consistent communication with our sales representatives that work alongside our distribution partners and leveraging our web portal platform to meet our sales objectives.

This position is responsible for communicating with our distribution partners, sales team, and production crew to maximize the volume of cider that can be shipped to each destination in order to meet our sales goals.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Establish relationships with our distribution partners in order to secure and book shipments of cider based on recommendations of 2 Towns sales crew and distribution partner inventory levels and sales rates. Understand and manage web portal environment to ensure distribution partner orders are accurate and shipped. Communicate with production manager to confirm inventory available to order. Investigate and file claims for any damaged or lost shipments to distribution partners. Work with Accounting Department to confirm accurate invoicing. The Fulfillment Assistant is responsible for selecting the mode of transportation (when not handled by distribution partners), planning transportation routes, tendering the orders for transportation, and tracking shipments.

Core duties and responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned:

I. Fulfillment

- Schedule and coordinate shipping needs for all orders from the ciderhouse
- Coordinate with cellar manager the finished goods available for shipment
- Coordinate with regional sales managers to develop suggested sales orders
- Maintain contact with distribution partner buyers to recommend and finalize weekly orders
- Confirm and enter finalized sales orders via company's web portal or direct submission from regional sales representative
- Coordinate with 3rd party logistics supplier to schedule weekly shipments
- Track shipments and confirm timely arrival at destination
- Reconcile and approve for payment any invoices related to finalized shipments

II. Miscellaneous

- Represent 2 Towns Ciderhouse courteously, accurately, and enthusiastically while on duty.
- Understand key logistics and inventory control concepts.
- Responsible for continual learning of advanced knowledge of our industry, especially cidermaking processes and sensory evaluation
- Participate in quarterly staff meetings and company-wide Cider Education events
- Represent 2 Towns Ciderhouse at the Annual Harvest Party
- Review own time cards on a regular basis
- Adhere to 2 Towns Ciderhouse safety policies and procedures at all times
- Observe and follow all policies described in the Employee Handbook
- Other duties as assigned

- Valid Driver's License and acceptable driving record
- Have access to a working personal vehicle
- Able to sit for long periods of time
- Must be 21 or older
- Able to lift 35lbs with own strength or move 50lbs using a hand truck
- Able to kneel and stoop occasionally
