Job Overview

Job Summary:

Taproom Associates are responsible for providing top-notch customer service to patrons of the Taproom at 2 Towns Ciderhouse. Duties include greeting customers, offering samples, cleaning the public space, restocking bar and restroom supplies, and handling cash. This 20 hours/week part-time position will be expected to work Fridays, Saturdays, and occasional Sundays.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Speak enthusiastically and knowledgeably about all 2 Towns Ciderhouse ciders.
- Pour cider taster trays, pints, glasses, and growlers.
- Verify that all those who enter the Taproom are 21 or over.
- Handle cash and card transactions, as well as operate register system.
- Stock Taproom cooler, apparel, and other supplies as needed. Alert Taproom manager to needs and issues as they arise in the Taproom.
- Work with other Taproom staff to provide best service possible to customers.
- Prepare and handle food.
- Maintain stringent cleaning standards.
- Keep a clean and organized working environment.
- Assist with administrative and janitorial tasks as needed.
- Attend required monthly All Staff Meetings.

- Adhere to all policies outlined in the Employee Handbook, as well as all company safety policies and procedures.
- Other tasks assigned by supervisor.
